BUSINESS LENDING & BUSINESS RESOURCES

REI Oklahoma works with entrepreneurs and business owners across the state—especially those facing economic and social barriers—to deliver the training, capital and resources needed to build and grow successful businesses.

- **Over \$196.8 million** in total financial impact
- **130** trainings, workshops and networking events hosted
- More than **1,300 unique** business owners served
- **Over 4,500** quality jobs created or retained
- Helped **64** businesses secure funding through loans and New Markets Tax Credits
- **54%** invested in rural Oklahoma, **46%** in urban areas

HOMEOWNERSHIP

Homeownership is one of the most powerful tools for building stability and generational opportunity. REI Oklahoma helps Oklahomans, especially first-time buyers, access the resources they need to make that dream a reality.

- **Over \$30.4 million** in impact through the Down Payment Assistance Program
- **141 families** became homeowners
- **89%** were first-time homebuyers
- **Over \$13.5 million** in total impact through multi-family housing projects providing needed housing for **101** individuals/families
- **46** trainings to realtors and mortgage lenders
